






WHY THE UPDATE?

- Update 2008 Keiser Park Master Plan (Ph. 1 built)
- Develop plan for a Phase 2 & 3 improvements
 - Vet previous concept of Aquatics Complex& Gym/Community Center
 - Consider multi-purpose use of the site, such as emergency evacuation
- Incorporate **park expansion** properties
- Locate proposed facilities and estimate costs
- Evaluate **funding mechanisms** & project partners
- CEQA documentation






 Proposed changes occur closest to the creek and the area used for parking (dirt lot)

 Master Plan




