

- CEQA documentation






PARK DESIGN CONCEPTS

- Existing ball fields in center of park
- Multi-use sports fields along eastern edge
- New nature play/gathering area in NE corner

CENTRAL PROGRAMMING




- Aguatic/Rec Center in center of park

SUMMARY from Round 2

Priorities for the Park Design:

- Aquatic Center/Recreation Center close to the High School to facilitate use and promote connectivity between sites
- Increasedvehicular accesş morepedestrian pathways, and expandeφarking
- Enhanced, expanded, and protectedtural spaces (e.g., Oak Grove, nature walks, garden, nature play, trees, etc.)
- Development/changes to the park to occur in the center of the park and along the park edges
- Consider options toninimize impact on immediate neighborhood






